INSTRUCTIONS FOR PACKING SAMPLES FOR TRANSPORT

- 1. Place samples in a zip-lock biohazard bag. Make sure that samples with different storage requirements are packaged separately.
- 2. Make sure the zip lock seal is closed.
- 3. Put the requisitions, corresponding to the samples, in the back pocket of the bag.
- 4. Store the specimens as indicated, until delivered to the lab.

NOTES

- a. Urine and histology specimen cups and microbiology specimens should be individually packaged with the requisitions in the outside pocket.
- b. Make sure that specimen containers (such as urines, feces, and sputums) have their covers securely tightened to prevent leakage.
