24-HOUR URINE COLLECTION

Instructions for the patient:

- 1. Always refrigerate specimen during the collection.
- 2. Label the container (not the cover) with your name (first and last) and date of birth.
- 3. To begin a 24-hour collection, urinate into the toilet. In the "COLLECTION BEGUN" section of the collection form, record the time of this void on the urine.
- 4. Collect and save all urine voided for the next 24 hours.
- 5. Urinate at **EXACTLY** 24 hours after the collection began and to include this urine in the collection bottle. If unable to void at this time, obtain a specimen as soon as possible. In the "COLLECTION COMPLETED" section of the collection form, record this time.
- 6. To begin a 24-hour collection **AFTER** the first morning void, continue the collection to and including the following morning (at 24 hours) void.
- 7. Preservative will be added after the collection is returned to the laboratory.

Instructions for the office:

- 1. 24-hour urine collection jugs and the accompanying 24-hour urine form can be obtained by the patient at the Lab Office. If you have questions call: 802-888-8340.
- 2. Patient may return the specimen container with the accompanying 24-hour urine form and a completed lab requisition directly to the lab office. They do need to register at the front desk prior to arriving at the lab.
- 3. Beginning and ending times must be entered in the appropriate spots on the form.
- 4. Sample must be refrigerated until submitted to the lab.
